RE: THANKSGIVING FOR YOUR ASSISTANCE.

The heading above concerns.

We teachers, pupils and the school committee members of Mtumba Primary School we are very grateful to you, your family and the whole society of Tanzania Life Project, for investment, US \$400 for classrooms renovation, electricity and a computer. Thank you very much for that and may the God bless you (Luke 12:33-34).

However we are very sorry for delaying our thanks to you. This was caused by the changes of the school management. Mr Sebyiga (whom you know) has been transferred to another school, and I, (Mr. John Maganga Solomon) have come for replacement. It's me from now on who will be concerned for communications.

On the other side, we Primary School have been given two machines by the village council, that's the flour milling machine, Computer and the oil milling machine. The carpentry machine has been given to Secondary School.

So far we have done the following:-

With the money you gave us, we brought 20 bags of ceent, 2 bag of lime, 72 litres of various paints and transported the goods. We collected other required materials and renovated two classrooms inside parts.

With the machines you gave us. We called a parents meeting to contribute on constructing rooms for the machines. Together they agreed to contribute, and the construction began at once. So far the contributions of Tshs. 350,000/= building stones, sand some water and men power, the building of two rooms is at the 6th course of cement blocks. But the contribution has been poor due to drought on our land. Thus the construction speed has been poor. The building is situated 100 metres southwards from the headteachers office.
